Grand Lodge Academic and Merit Scholarship

Eligibility:

- An applicant must be related to a DOE in good standing, has been accepted or attending an accredited college or, a DOE in good standing attending an accredited college.
- Selection will be based on academics, extracurricular activities, work, and volunteerism.
- The applicant has never received a scholarship from the Grand Lodge, Benevolent, Patriotic Order of DOES.

Requirements for maintaining the scholarship:

- Show proof of a B/3.0 average at the end of the school year.
- Show proof of enrollment for the following school year.

Selection Process:

- A panel of select PSPs, will review all application information.
- The \$20,000 scholarship distribution is as follows for a four-year degree:
 - Freshman would receive 10% of \$20,000 = \$2,000
 - Sophomore would receive 20% of \$20,000 = \$4,000
 - Junior would receive 30% of \$20,000 = \$6,000
 - Senior would receive 40% of \$20,000 = \$8,000
- A two-year degree/trade school:
 - 1st year would receive 30% of \$10,000 = \$3,000
 - 2nd year would receive 70% of \$10,000 = \$7,000
- Payments will be made to the college in August and January.

The following information must be enclosed with this application:

1. A copy of an **official** transcript (**sealed**) from your most recent school.
2. A letter of recommendation from two or more, i.e., principal, administrator, pastor, guidance counselor, teacher, employer, etc. This **excludes** any recommendation from a family member.
3. Documentation of all honors, awards, and volunteer services (copies accepted). A note on company letterhead signed by a supervisor for volunteer and work hours will be accepted.

Applications must be **POSTMARKED** no later than **June 1st**. Please mail your application to:
